Reproduction of these standards either in hard copy or soft copy (including posting to the web) is prohibited without copyright permission. All requests for copyright permission must be in writing and sent by email, facsimile or mail. The request should include the following information:

- For what purpose permission is needed
- Specific document name and number
- Portion of the document which will be reproduced (include tables, diagrams, charts, etc.)
- Intended audience
- How many reproduced copies are needed
- Whether or not this is hard copy only, or if also for soft copy such as (CD, intranet, website, etc.)

Examples of instances which copyright permission may be granted are:

- For educational purposes such as a presentation at a conference
- For reference by another association or standards developing organization
- For insertion into government procurement contracts or documents
- For translation into another language, and if so, what language
- For publication in a textbook or other manuals
